

Will your child start 7th grade in fall?

Get vaccines before the fall rush.

Vaccines help children stay healthy, so they can keep doing the things they love!

Required for 7th grade:

- Tdap.

Required for K–12:

- Hepatitis B.
- MMR.
- Polio.
- Varicella (chickenpox).

Recommended:

- HPV.
- Meningococcal.
- Flu.
- COVID-19.
- Hepatitis A.

How can I find out if my child needs vaccines?

Visit myirmobile.com and register to view immunization records. You can print a Certificate of Immunization Status for school.

You can also contact your child's healthcare provider for help.

Where can my child get vaccines?

- **At a healthcare provider's office.** The provider can make sure your child is up to date and do other important health checks.
- **At a pharmacy.** Call before you go to ask if they:
 - Have the vaccines your child needs.
 - Have age restrictions.
 - Charge a fee (even with insurance).
- **At a vaccine event.** Visit tpchd.org/kidsvax for locations.
